The question is, are we ready to pull off the highway and take it slow through his canyons, mountain peaks, and soul-filled streets?

God has a sight-seeing tour for us. It has already begun. And for those who are looking, it promises to show us **God's vision** for us as people who love Him, love others, and love ourselves as blessed Ones for whom Jesus died.


